OFFICIAL RULES:

- 1) No entry fee will be charged.
- 2) All entrants must be 14 years or older to enter and are to be amateur bakers, and are residents of Harrison County, Indiana. Professional bakers may not enter.
- 3) Individual entries only, no business, or dining establishment may enter.
- 4) Pie must be entered in the name of the person who baked it.
- 5) Entrants will be required to produce a Jay C Food Store of Corydon receipt, dated between May 29 and June 18, 2017, showing the purchase of at least three items from the recipe (i.e. sugar, flour, berries, butter) for each pie entered.
- 6) You may enter as many pies as you like.
- 7) Pies will be judged solely on the decorative value of the pastry (piecrust). Pies will not be cut or tasted.
- 8) Pies must be made from scratch, including the crust and filling; absolutely no commercial pies, please!
- 9) Pies may be 8" or 9" or 10" disposable container.
- 10) Pies will be on display all week in the Homecomer's Hall.
- 11) Recipes must be submitted with your pie and the winning pie recipes may appear on our web-page or Facebook page. If you enter a pie, you agree to be photographed and have your recipe published on our web-page or our Facebook page, and you agree that it may be used in our promotional materials.
- 12) All recipes become the property of the Harrison County Agricultural Society. No recipes can be submitted from a copyrighted site without written permission. Be sure to check that you are following laws for use with intellectual property, or copyright law.
- 13) Winners will be announced at the conclusion of judging and prizes will be awarded at that time.
- 14) A form with the entrant's name, address, phone number and complete recipe PLUS the receipt (see rule #5) must accompany all entries.

- 15) By participating in this event, The Harrison County Fair Decorative Pie Pastry Contest, I agree to abide by the contest rules and decisions of the judges. Entrants will agree to release the event, and all who participate in the production of this event, from any liability without limitations.

- 16) **Applications for entry are due July 18th by 3:00 PM at the Talmage Windell Memorial Agriculture Building at the Harrison County Fairgrounds, Corydon Indiana.**
